Project itinerary

You will arrive on Sunday and have plenty of time to settle into your accommodation before starting your week as an Agriculture Development Volunteer, here in Cambodia!

Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first week at this location, you will join our orientation day, to familiarise yourself with the surroundings as well as the local culture. Your programme will continue as usual from Tuesday onward throughout the rest of the week.

Schedule

- Introduction meeting, House rules, Setting Expectations, Health and Safety Advice and handling of documents.
- Khmer Do's and Don'ts, Khmer Culture Lessons and Khmer Language Lessons.
- Tour around the compound and local area; where to find local shops, and arrange a sim-card if necessary.
- Lunch
- Introduction to the Project, Project site and start participating on the project.

Tuesday to Friday

A typical day during this programme may look like this:

- Breakfast
- Join the training session with an introduction to integrated farming
- Join the construction at the centre and engage in land preparation
- Engage in a personal project: workshop and group work
- Lunch
- Make a model of crops or vegetable beds
- Visit some local families who are working with vegetables
- Help the families with their daily vegetable work
- Prepare Earth block mixture (clay) and materials for binding
- Dinner

Evenings and Weekends

At the end of your day as a volunteer, you can choose to explore the area or simply relax with new friends back at your accommodation. Many of our volunteers enjoy mixing with their new volunteer friends during the week and plan their weekend adventures together!

Please note: This schedule can be changed and/or amended depending on weather conditions, local conditions and unforeseen circumstances.

Places to Visit

Nearby, you'll find a park where you can relax or play volleyball with locals during your free time. Further, bikes are available at our centre which you can use to explore your surroundings and get about.

Further away is Siem Reap, which is two hours away from the accommodation. Our volunteers often head there at the weekends to explore the famous Angkor Wat, zip-wire through rainforest canopies, discover breathtaking waterfalls and do a little trekking!
