Wednesday

Try out cooking skills with our traditional Sri Lankan cooking experience! Thereafter, it's a visit to one local temple, where we will learn about some of the Buddhist religious rituals practised by Sri Lankans. You will also practice some meditation techniques to soothe and calm your soul!

Thursday

We start off early today with an early morning visit to a family practising traditional Batik painting. Have a fun-filled, creative workshop, challenging your creative side with an original Batik design of your own. Alternatively, you can try to master the techniques of a traditional Batik design. Work with vibrant colours, techniques, tools and dyes. After lunch with the family who are delivering the lesson, we visit the sacred 'Temple of the Tooth'.

Friday

Today we visit a sacred temple in a small forest and a holy Hindu temple. Following our walk, an Indian lunch awaits you in the city followed by a relaxing Ayurvedic massage later on.

Places to Visit

You will visit many places during your Cultural Introduction week in Sri Lanka. However, should you wish to plan your own journeys, we recommend the Royal Botanical Gardens, Knuckles mountain range, Udawatta Kele Sanctuary, Hortons Plains National Park and the Railway Museum.
