

During the morning session, you'll be given a Filipino Language Lesson to help you interact with the locals while you're staying at Palawan. Just before lunch, you'll take part in a clean-up drive around the village plaza. Thereafter, you'll have a craft session to make your own souvenir bracelet, and a cooking class. Cooking class is next, and this will extend into dinner, giving you an excellent experience of the delicious cuisine.

Wednesday

Today entails a trip after to the beautiful city of Puerto Princesa. Home to the Puerto Princesa Underground River, a Butterfly Garden and the Immaculate Conception Cathedral, there'll be plenty of sights and sounds to capture your interests as you explore the city.
