## Project itinerary

As a Medical Outreach Volunteer in Cambodia, you will teach basic healthcare concepts, so ensure that you come prepared to teach class and answer questions!

The standard schedule for the Medical Outreach Project has you working Monday to Friday, with the last Thursday of the month off. It is worth remembering though, that changes can sometimes be made, and a full-time project coordinator is on hand to cooperate with you to maintain as flexible a timetable as possible.

## Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first week at this location, you will join our orientation day, to familiarise yourself with the surroundings as well as the local culture. Your programme will continue as usual from Tuesday onward throughout the rest of the week.

## Schedule

- Introduction meeting, House rules, Setting Expectations, Health and Safety Advice and handling of documents.
- Khmer Do's and Don'ts, Khmer Culture Lessons and Khmer Language Lessons.
- Tour around the compound and local area; where to find local shops, and arrange a sim-card if necessary.

## Tuesday to Friday

Your workday will be from 08:00 – 17:00, with a lunch break at around 11:00. Daily tasks can differ drastically from week to week during the course of this programme, so a degree of flexibility is needed! During your programme, you will work with your project coordinator to develop lessons for students, so you'll have plenty of support if teaching is new to you! Further, you will also have the opportunity to introduce elements of your own health care knowledge, using creative means to engage with your audience.

## Evenings and Weekends

At the end of a day on this Medical Outreach Volunteer project, you can choose to explore the area or simply relax with new friends back at your accommodation. Many of our volunteers enjoy mixing with their new volunteer friends during the week and plan their weekend adventures together!
