Project itinerary

You will arrive in Nusa Penida on Sunday, and will have a short introduction on the beach to get familiarise yourself with your new exciting surroundings! Thereafter, you will get to know more about Nusa Penida, facilities, places to visit, etc.

Turtle Conservation & Rehabilitation Volunteer in Nusa Penida - Schedule

Monday

Following breakfast, you will see a presentation about the Turtle Conservation project and also receive a project briefing which will help you to understand the do's and don'ts at the project. After that you will engage in the typical activities you'll be doing throughout the week, such as feeding the turtles, cleaning the tanks, catching live food for turtles and also cleaning the beach. In the evening, you will then see a documentary about Turtles which will help you to widen your knowledge about these amazing creatures.

Tuesday

After having breakfast on Tuesday, you will start cleaning the tanks, feeding the turtles and collecting seaweed and live food for turtles. In addition, you will also create turtle toys, clean the beach and provide medicine for injured turtles if present.

Wednesday

After breakfast, you will start cleaning the tanks, feeding the turtles and collecting seaweed and live food for turtles. In addition, you will also create turtle toys and provide medicine for injured turtles if present. In the evening, you can play either volleyball, badminton or football.

Thursday

On Thursday, after breakfast, you will be cleaning tanks, feeding the turtles and collecting seaweed. You will also continue creating turtle toys and provide medicine for injured turtles if present.

On either, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday you will visit an amazing location called Crystal Bay which has a breathtaking view. Your local coordinators will decide the day on which you visit this

exotic location.

Thursday night will be a special one for you to enjoy the welcome and farewell dinner by a Bonfire at the beach. Further, this would be a great opportunity to get to know the newcomers and say goodbye to those who are leaving.

Friday

On Friday, after having breakfast, you will feed the turtles and get an amazing opportunity to release turtles to the sea. However, please note that this opportunity is only if you are leaving the programme this week. If you continue another week at the project, you will engage in the regular activities at the turtle conservation centre. After lunch, you can engage in all the usual activities. These include feeding the turtles, cleaning tanks and measuring the turtles' growth.

Other activities you might engage in are as follows:

- Cleaning the beach
- Making garbage bins for local area
- Making Turtles/Environment campaign for local area
- Releasing injured turtles after treatment/ clean private beach
- Turtles site construction work: such as extra turtle tank or wall, painting the walls etc.
- Collecting turtle information such as length of carapace, size of flippers, checking its weight etc.

Although there aren't many shops or activities available on Nusa Penida, you will nearly always be close to a beach that lets you soak up the rays of the sun or go swimming during your free time.

Evenings and Weekends

At the end of your day as a Turtle Conservation & Rehabilitation Volunteer, here in Nusa Penida, there's lots to explore! Alternatively, you can simply relax with new friends back at your accommodation. In fact, many of our volunteers enjoy mixing with their new volunteer friends during the week and plan their weekend adventures together!
