Project itinerary

A typical day on your Childcare Volunteer Placement in Costa Rica will start at around 07:30 and end just after 16:30. However, you will only be teaching for around 3 – 6 hours per day, with opportunities to get involved in other activities. Also – you won't be on your own! You will have the support of local staff to guide you as you work with these little cherubs!

Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first day as a childcare volunteer, you will join our orientation day, to get accustomed to your local surroundings as well as local culture. Your programme will continue as usual from Tuesday onward throughout the rest of the week.
