Project itinerary

The normal working hours for each day are usually from 8:00 am until 1:30 pm. However, these could change if it is deemed necessary by the hospital routines. Further, your working schedule will be arranged by the hospital staff when you arrive to ensure that you gain the best possible experiences during your stay.

Importantly, don't worry about being thrown in at the deep end! Staff will be there to support you in your volunteering, and ensure that you are able to observe or engage at a level you're happy with!

Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first week at this location, you will join our orientation day, to familiarise yourself with the surroundings as well as the local culture.
