## Project itinerary

Your days as a Mangrove Conservation Volunteer will be varied, working with plants, with children, and with other volunteers. All activities are supported by the local staff who are there to help, whenever needed, so don't worry if you need a little support now and again!

## Weekly Schedule

After meeting with the team and getting a brief introduction on history and taboos, your main tasks throughout the week will be:

- Working on the mangrove regeneration program.
- Setting up seedbed.
- Drawing sketch about mangrove forest conservation.
- Leading mangrove-oriented environmental education for surrounding children.
- Working on mangrove sustainable exploitation program.

### **Please note:**

Cost of transport to locations is not included, but will usually be around £1.50 per day.

This schedule can be changed depending on weather conditions and unforeseen circumstances.
