You will arrive on Sunday, and have plenty of time to relax and settle into your accommodation, ahead of your exciting week!

Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first week at this location, you will join our orientation day, to get accustomed to your surroundings as well as local culture. Thereafter, your Philippines Kindergarten Volunteer Programme will continue as usual from Tuesday onward throughout the rest of the week.

Daily Schedule

Tuesday to Friday

On Tuesday the day follows a similar pattern, except this time you'll be on the beach helping with a coastal cleaning programme. On Wednesday it's back to the Mangrove plantation. Thursday is a day of giving environmental talks to local children. Lastly, Friday will be spent back at the Mangrove plantation.
